

EXAMPLE PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Soil Quality Restoration

To be pre-approved for soil quality restoration project funding, some cities require that you provide a project description. Below is one example of what to include in a project description.

What your project description should include:

- Size of project (square feet) and description of what areas will be treated
- Statement that deep aeration or core aeration will be used
- Statement about the thickness of the compost application
- Expected installation date
- Name of person or company completing the soil quality restoration
- Other project background or information you think is helpful or necessary to include

EXAMPLE:

On our property, we have experienced very compacted soils and have had some ponding issues. In some areas grass will not grow, while in other it becomes hard to mow because the soil stays wet.

Soil quality restoration (SQR) will be applied to 5,000 square feet of lawn at (project address). The entire lawn and right of way areas will be treated on the property. The SQR will be completed by (landscaping company name). I have been working with (landscaping company employee name) and have ensured that deep aeration and a 3/4 inch compost layer will be used. This project will be installed sometime during Fall 2020. Currently, we are expecting an installation date around the end of September assuming weather or other issues don't become an issue.
