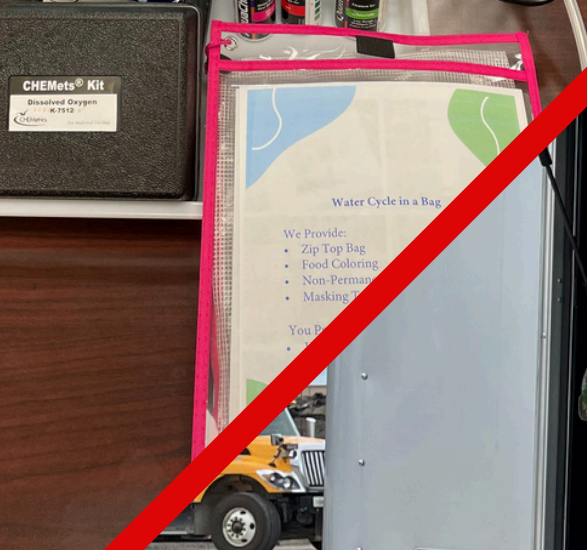
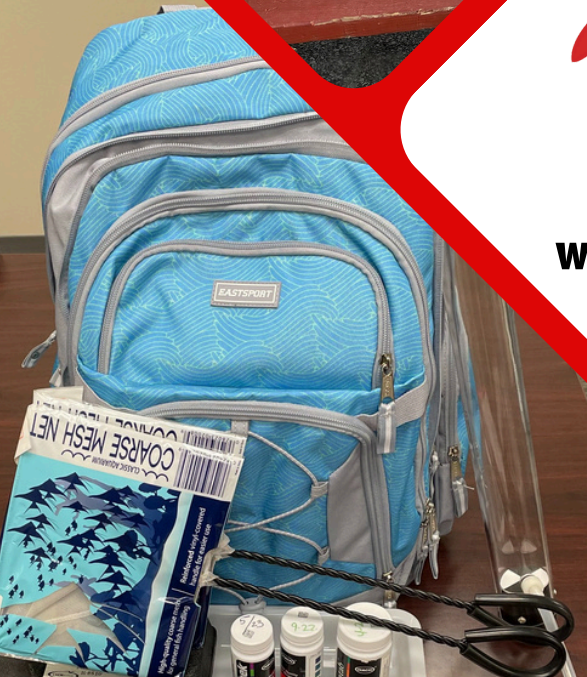

Root Box Demonstration Activity

A fun, interactive learning tool for all ages! Each photo represents a grass or flower found in Iowa. The twine lengths correspond with the root lengths of each plant. You'll be surprised to learn how deep those roots go!



Stream Trailer

This stream trailer uses a pump system (plugged into a power source or generator) to flow water through a table filled with a sandy material that simulates streamflow through a landscape. Participants create their own flow paths and use the accessories to create their own watershed!

Root Banner

This scale model of Leadplant and Big Blue Stem with roots (approximately 14 feet long) is a quick and effective way to educate about the power of native plants for soaking up water. Grommets allow it to be hung, or you can simply unroll in front of a crowd.

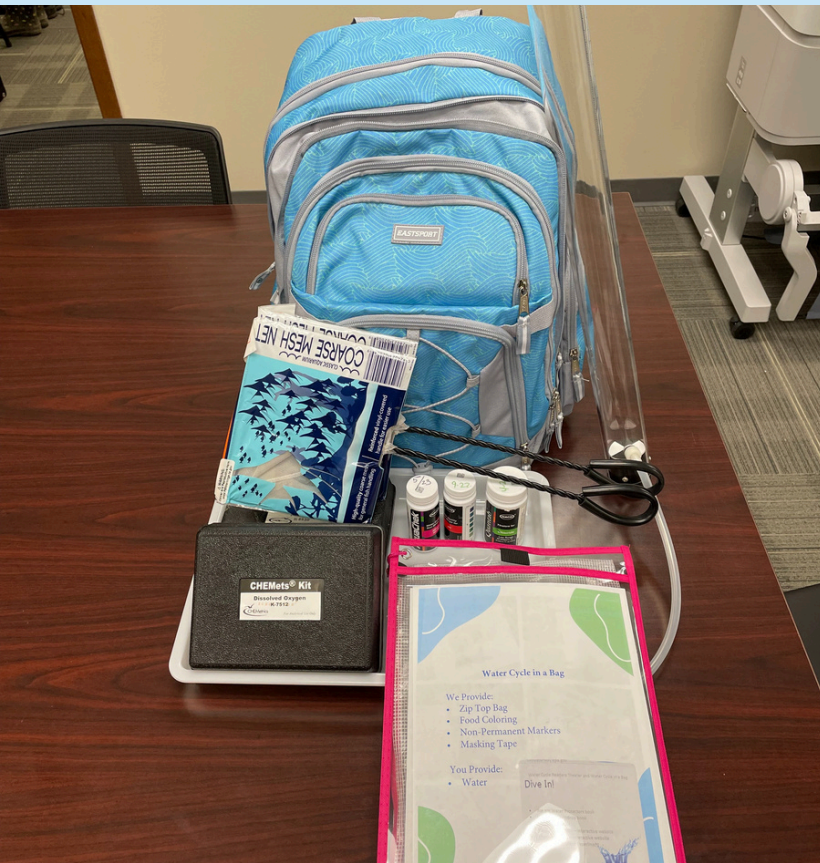
Brochures, Flyers, and Freebies

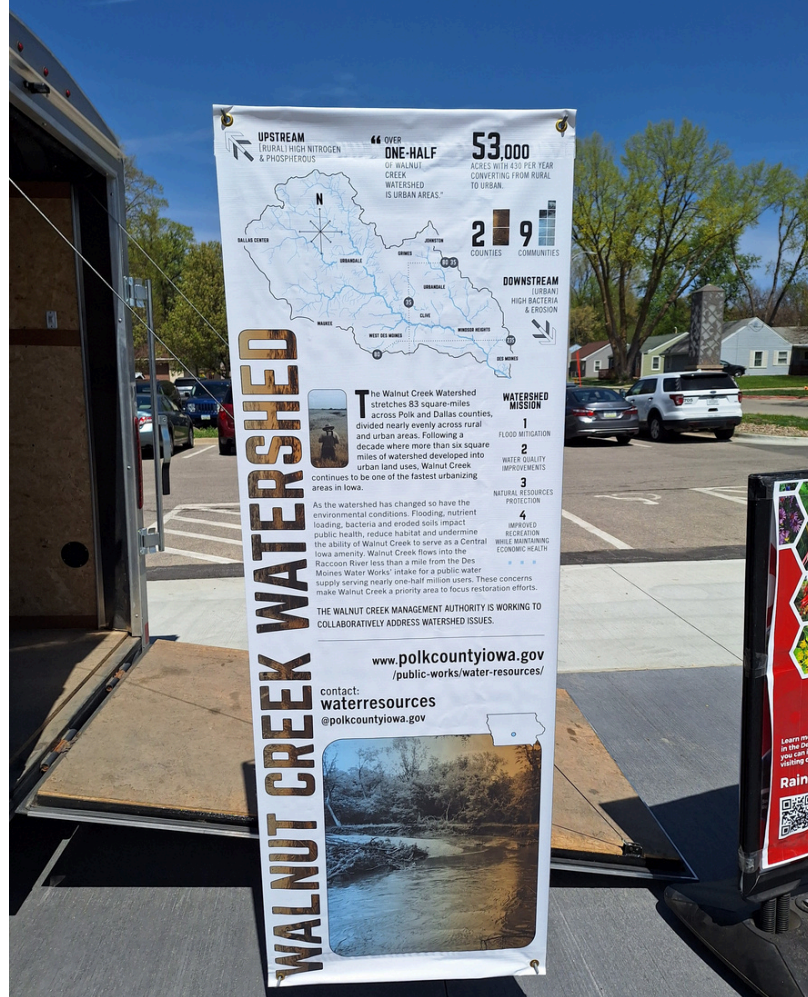
